

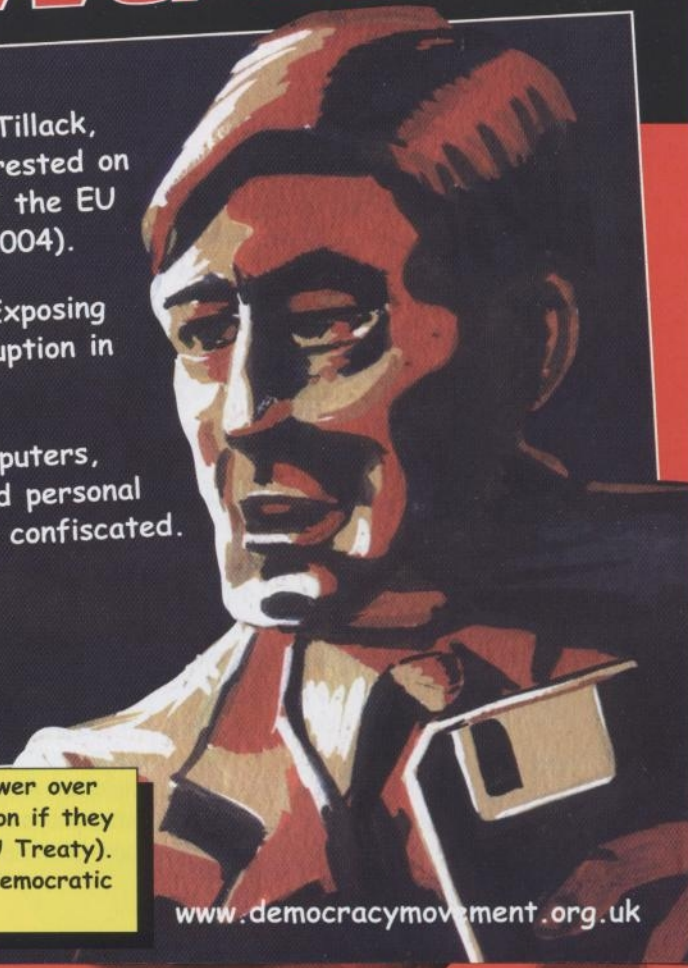
TAKING LIBERTIES
